Meeting called to order at 6:06pm

  - Prep the fields – chalk and install bases on Friday night. Banners going up Friday. Complex closed Friday. Steve Landman to send out email to set time for set up. 10-4 approx.
  - Mark sent maps today, fire dept set up for parade. Becky Rosen picking up donuts and coffee.
  - Donuts are paid for the entire year; anyone can pick up. 4 dozen every Saturday.
  - Mark will be at the field in the morning to direct volunteers.
  - Becky is getting the Coffee and Dave is getting donuts and chick fil a – 100 donated sandwiches
  - Jersey Mikes is bringing sandwiches, buy ticket and get sandwich.
  - Riches ice cream? Unknown if they will come depending on weather
  - Order for announcing is Juniors to T-ball – so team parents can stay with younger kids longer
  - Sara Boyer volunteered for national anthem.
- Child protection Act – nothing says it is required, just highly encouraged. Reached out to district about requirements and have not heard anything. Waiting for district to respond and give more clarification.
  - D5 umpire in chief sent email saying it was required for everyone. Concussion and Child protection training.

- Juniors
  - First game Wednesday at the complex
  - Approval from San Bernardino to carry 17 players on juniors’ team.

  - Allow new board members to forgo their volunteer event. Board members don't have to sign up to volunteer because they are already there.
- Katie
  - Registration is officially closed - 6 teams of 12 for T-ball.
  - T-ball suggestion – 12 batters an inning is very long, got through 2 innings. Suggesting half innings, 6 players per inning. Will have to put it in the bylaws. Based on time limit and how many innings. 6 innings or 70 minutes until we cap the T-ball teams at 10. We had an influx of kids this year. Split the team in half and trade off innings.
- Motion to update T-Ball playing rules: Hard stop at 70 minutes or 6 Inning max. Batting order is split in half. 12 players split to 6 players each inning, 11 to 5 and 6, 10 to 5 and 5, 9 to 5 and 4. Home team tracks innings and time. Steve Gill will update language and send via email
  - Katie is motioning, David Yaffee is seconding. Gaby is notifying the teams of this change. 13 votes yes.
- Steve Gill
  - Opening day program is done with inside goes to print tomorrow. Set up PA to test. Banners will be here to put up Friday and the aluminum signs.
  - Umpire sign up sent out to farm managers first and then to minors/majors. Worked well. 2 umpires for minors' preseason and regular season and 1 umpire assigned to tournament games. A few games still need plate assigned. Juniors still need to be assigned.
  - Can we put a freezer in equipment room? Look into and talk to electrician. Top loader ideal. For buns for snack bar.
- Umpire Discussion
  - \$60 per game for umpires, helps get farm managers exposure and appreciate how hard it is. If there are no consequences, then no one will commit. If you don't fulfill requirement check will be cashed. A manager last year said "Cash my check" the board does not want checks cashed they want time. A 2-game suspension was implemented this year.
